Important Notice for Parents, Teachers, and Students

1. **Summer Break & Reopening:** In strict alignment with regional weather conditions and CBSE norms, regular classes will run through **April 2026**. The school will remain closed for students throughout **May and June** for Summer Vacation. June will be strictly utilised by the faculty for new admissions, curriculum blueprinting, and lesson planning. Students must report back on **July 1, 2026**.
2. **Attendance Compliance:** As per CBSE mandates, a minimum of **75% attendance** is strictly compulsory for students to be eligible to sit for final examinations. Parents must ensure regular attendance, especially during the post-Diwali village mela season (November 9–23) when core syllabus pacing takes place.
3. **Event Alignments:** To protect core instructional time, the **Annual Sports Week** and **Grand Annual Function** are scheduled back-to-back right after the local fair season wraps up. The **Educational Tour** is intentionally integrated into the winter break to ensure zero academic loss.
